COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

EXPO KATOWICE - INNOVATION IN INDUSTRY

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

1. The competition entitled “EXPO KATOWICE - INNOVATION IN INDUSTRY”, hereinafter referred to as the “Competition”, is organised by the following co-organisers:
 - a) EXPO Katowice S.A.
 - b) Editorial office of “Napędy i Sterowanie” monthly magazine, hereinafter referred to as: “Napędy i Sterowanie magazine”, hereinafter jointly referred to as “the Organiser”.
2. The aim of the Competition is to promote and popularise talented university students in the field of industry, including robotics and automation, mining, geology, mechanics, electricity and electronics, IT, mechanical engineering, as well as to promote and contribute to the development of Polish and global industrial economy, in line with global ecological trends.
3. The subject-matter of the Competition is the development of innovative solutions for industry, hereinafter referred to as “the Work”.
4. The Competition is open to individual students as well as research clubs or teams of students.
5. The Competition can be attended by students of universities.
6. **Participation in the Competition is free of charge.**
7. Works entered to the Competition shall be assessed by the Competition Jury.
8. The Entry Form is an integral part of these Rules and Regulations and should be completed in paper version.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION

Article 2

1. The Work must be submitted by 01/08/2022 in sealed envelopes marked “Competition: EXPO KATOWICE - INNOVATION IN INDUSTRY”.
2. Works, in the number of 2 copies, should be sent to the Organisers’ addresses:

The work should be accompanied by the signed Competition Rules and Regulations and the entry form, which are available on the Organisers’ websites:

3. Works should include a maximum of 20 slides with description of:
 - innovative features of the solution
 - application possibilities in industry
 - possible economic effects of implementation.
4. The work and the signed Rules and Regulations as well the entry form should be submitted to the secretary’s office of

5. By entering the work into the competition, the Competition Participant declares and confirms that he/she has exclusive and unlimited economic and moral rights to the work submitted. Should the statement referred to above prove to be untrue, the Competition Participant shall release the Organiser from any liability and shall cover any damage that the Organisers have suffered due to claims made by third parties.
6. Furthermore, the Competition Participant declares that simultaneously with entering the work into the Competition, he/she grants a free licence to the Organisers to use the work for the duration of the Competition, without territorial limitations, for the needs related to the Competition, by saving the work in Organisers' computer memory or server. The licence covers the use of work by - including but not limited to - recording and reproducing the work using any technique, among others magnetic recording, digital or audio-visual method, on any media, without limitation as to the quantity and volume of the output, as well as public distribution of the product.
7. The winner of the Competition agrees to introduce graphical changes, not interfering with the substantive content of the product, allowing the product to be presented on websites.
8. At the same time, the Competition Participant allows the Organisers to publish his/her personal data and image. The Participant grants the Organiser free permission to use his/her image in terms of recording and multiplying by any technique and distributing the materials which bear his/her image, for advertising and promotional purposes by means of displaying, exhibiting, making them available to the public in such a way that everyone can access them at a time and place chosen at one's own discretion on Organisers' websites and in social media, such as Facebook, Instagram and others, for the a period of no less than one year from the date on which his/her image has been established and recorded.
9. The Competition Participant declares that in terms of accepting the award, the bodies representing the Participant and/or persons authorised by them to accept the award, have granted the Organiser free permission to use their image in terms of recording and multiplying by any technique and distributing the materials which bear their image, for advertising and promotional purposes by means of displaying, exhibiting, making them available to the public in such a way that everyone can access them at a time and place chosen at one's own discretion on Organisers' websites and in social media, such as Facebook, Instagram and others, for the a period of no less than one year from the date on which their image has been established and recorded. At the Organisers' request, the Competition Participant is obliged to send the above-mentioned consents in writing.

ORGANISER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Article 3

1. The Organiser of the Competition - EXPO Katowice S.A. - shall be responsible for the following activities:

 - b) verifying the incoming materials for the Competition in respect of formal issues,
2. The Organiser of the Competition - "Napiędy i Sterowanie" magazine - shall be responsible for the following activities:
 - a) compiling the "Summary of entry forms" and sending it to the members of Competition Jury.

AWARDS AND THEIR GRANTING

Article 4

1. Diplomas and cash awards for taking the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place are to be awarded in the Competition.
2. The following cash awards shall be awarded to the Participants:

- for taking the first place: PLN 5,000 gross (in words: PLN five thousand)
for taking the second place: PLN 4,000 gross (in words: PLN four thousand)
for taking the third place: PLN 3,000 PLN gross (in words: PLN three thousand)
3. The overall award pool is PLN 12,000 gross (in words: PLN twelve thousand).
 4. The Participant (natural person) shall deduct the cash award by 10% flat-rate income tax (pursuant to Article 30(1)(2) of the Personal Income Tax).
 5. Only one 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place may be awarded.
 6. The university whose student, group of students or research clubs become winners of the Competition **shall be awarded a diploma.**

METHOD OF GRANTING THE AWARDS

Article 5

1. The work is assessed by a Jury, selected from among the Competition Jury members, composed of representatives from the industry as well as representatives of universities, scientific institutions and organisers.
2. Only the solutions meeting the formal requirements specified in Article 2 hereof shall be submitted to the Competition Jury for evaluation.
3. The Competition Jury evaluates the solutions and grants the awards.
4. Competition Jury deliberations are secret and its decisions are final.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE RESULTS OF THE COMPETITION

Article 6

1. Winners of the Competition shall be announced on 6 September 2022.
2. The ceremony, during which the Competition Jury will officially grant the awards, shall be held on 8 September 2022 at 11:00 a.m. in the Auditorium of the International Congress Centre in Katowice during the EXPO KATOWICE International Fair - Fair of Mining, Power Industry and Metallurgy.

PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

Article 7

1. The Controller of personal data collected in connection with the Competition is EXPO Katowice S.A. with its registered office in Katowice, at al. Korfantego 51/46 and the Editorial Office of "Napędy i Sterowanie" monthly magazine with its registered office in Racibórz, ul. Środkowa 5.
2. The Controllers have entered into a co-controlling agreement and agreed that:
 - a) information obligations (pursuant to Article 13, Article 14 of GDPR) shall be performed by EXPO Katowice S.A. with its registered office in Katowice, al. Korfantego 51/46; contact with the Controller - phone no.: +48 32/ 353 70 23, e-mail: expo@expo-katowice.com
 - b) other obligations, in particular with regard to exercise of rights by a data subject, shall be fulfilled by the Editorial office of "Napędy i Sterowanie" monthly magazine, with its registered office in Racibórz, ul. Środkowa 5; contact with the Controller - phone no.: +48 507 061 574 e-mail: ryszard.klencz@drukart.pl
3. Providing personal data is not a statutory requirement and is done on the basis of giving consent, which is a condition for participation in the Competition. Failure to give consent shall result in ineligibility to participate in the Competition. Legal basis of personal data processing is Article 6(1)(a) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR").
4. Personal data shall be processed until the announcement of Competition winners and for the limitation period for claims related to participation in the Competition (up to 6 years) pursuant to Article 6(1)(f), which is a legitimate interest of the Controllers, as well as for a possible period for making statutory settlements (Article 6(1)(c)).

5. The data subject has the following rights:
 - a) pursuant to Article 15 of GDPR - the right of access to his/her personal data, including the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him/her are being processed as well as information on the purposes of processing and categories of personal data; pursuant to Article 16 of GDPR - the right to obtain from the Controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data and to have incomplete personal data completed;
 - b) pursuant to Article 17 of GDPR - the right to obtain from the Controller the erasure of personal data concerning the data subject without undue delay;
 - c) pursuant to Article 18 of GDPR - the right to obtain from the Controller restriction of processing of personal data in the following cases: (I) the accuracy of the personal data processed by the Controller is contested by the Competition Participant; (II) the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests the restriction of their use instead; (III) the Controller no longer needs the personal data but they are required by the Competition Participant for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims; (IV) the data subject has objected to processing pursuant to Article 21(1) of GDPR pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the Controller override those of the data subject's objection;
 - d) pursuant to Article 20 of GDPR - the right to receive the personal data concerning him/her, which he or she has provided to the Controller, in a structured, commonly used format and to transmit those data to another controller, where technically feasible. This right applies if the processing is carried out by automated means and data are processed on the basis of consent or pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of GDPR;
 - e) pursuant to Article 21 of GDPR - the right to object, on grounds relating to his/her particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning him/her which is based on item (e) or (f) of Article 6(1), including profiling based on those provisions.
6. The data subject has the right to withdraw his/her consent at any time.
7. The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority - President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, The Controller informs that the Participants' personal data shall not be transferred to a third country (i.e. a country other than a member state of the European Union, Iceland, Liechtenstein or Norway) or to any international organisation.
8. Categories of personal data recipients: jury, business partners in performance of agreements (including e.g. agents, service providers), law firms, accounting offices, telecommunication companies, postal operators, carrier companies, document archiving companies, partners providing technical services (e.g. e-mail services, maintenance of IT systems and websites).
9. The Controllers also inform that they do not use automated individual decision-making, including profiling, referred to in Article 22(1) and (4) of GDPR.

FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 8

1. Participation in the Competition is tantamount to accepting terms and conditions specified in this Rules and Regulations and abiding by their provisions.
2. Decisions in all matters not regulated by these Rules and Regulations shall be made by the Organisers.
3. For the purposes of the Competition, a definition of innovation has been indicated.
4. Exhibitors and/or persons participating in the Competition shall be entitled to share the information about the award or distinction granted.
